Interviews are by invitation only and are a required step in the process

Interviews are conducted in person by a member of our admissions committee

Interviews will be conducted in several key locations around the globe. Locations typically include: Cambridge, London, Mumbai, Santiago, Singapore, Beijing, and Shanghai

Behavioral Event Interviews

Your behavioral
event interview
will focus on:

Continuing to get to know you better

Probing details from your application

Learning specifics about your past experiences, accomplishments and actions... “tell me about a time when you...”

Obtaining more details about what you thought, felt, said or did in a specific situation



Interview Format

- Interview candidates will sign up for a 45 minute – one hour time block and will meet with one to two interviewers
- The interview will consist of both a behavioral assessment and a career assessment
